



What to Expect with Your Deck Project

Here are a few tips to help you prepare for your deck project:

Noise & Activity:

Board replacement also involves cutting and fastening, so expect some noise during the process.

Deck Access:

Please clear furniture, planters, grills, and any other belongings off the existing deck before work begins.

Electricity:

Please make an exterior or garage outlet available for crew use.

Material Deliveries & Dumpster:

A dumpster and new decking materials will be delivered a few days prior to installation. You do not need to be home for deliveries.

Starting Times:

Crews typically start between 7:00 - 8:30 a.m. Monday-Friday (some Saturdays).

Construction Site Safety:

The deck surface will be temporarily unusable during the project. Please avoid walking on or near the deck until work is complete.

Project Duration:

Most reskin projects take a few days to a week, depending on deck size and condition.

Upon Completion:

We'll clean the site, remove old boards, and ensure your new decking is secure and ready for use.

Final Inspection:

If required, your project manager will schedule a city inspection and ensure all permits are signed off.
